

# NMSA LMS TRAINING Courses and Descriptions

## MCM 1 & 2- PE/O & Public Involvement/Participation

### **Public Education Course for Citizens**

*This simple 5 minute course provides citizens with the basics of what stormwater runoff is while allowing them to take a pre test for existing knowledge and a post test for learning to meet a measurable objective.*

## MCM 3- Illicit Discharge Detection and Elimination

### **IDDE Basic for Municipal Employees:**

*.5 PDH - This course teaches the learner how to identify an illicit discharge, report an illicit discharge, and how to receive a call of an illicit discharge. The student will also learn key terms, historical context of the Clean Water Act, and what constitutes a potential pollutant. A score of 70% or higher is required to pass the course. Upon completion, learners will receive a completion certificate.*

### **IDDE for Responders:**

*.5 PDH - This course is for Municipal Employees that may need to respond or take a report of an illicit discharge. Students will learn what information should be asked for or gathered when an illicit discharge is reported and what considerations are necessary. The student will also learn key terms, historical context of the Clean Water Act, and what constitutes a potential pollutant. This course expands on the IDDE Basic Municipal module with learning checks throughout and a quiz. A score of 70% or higher is required to pass the course. Upon completion, learners will receive a completion certificate.*

### **IDDE for Investigators:**

*1.0 PDH - This course is for Municipal Employees who may need to inspect, confirm, and eliminate illicit discharges. Students will learn to inspect discharges for pollutants, conduct investigations to find illicit discharges, and confirm and eliminate the sources of illicit discharges. Key term understanding is accelerated in this course with a deeper dive into:*

- *Standard Operating Procedures*
- *Illicit Discharge Terms*
- *System Vulnerability Factors*
- *Elimination Example and confirmation*
- *Future Prevention*
- *Investigative Methods*
- *Testing*
- *Tracking*
- *Other IDDE Concepts*

*This is an advanced IDDE course designed for IDDE Investigators within an MS4. This course is appropriate for all personnel conducting or managing IDDE investigations and encompasses the IDDE basic (municipal module) and intermediate courses (responder module). A score of 70% or higher is required to pass the course. Upon completion, learners will receive a completion certificate.*

## **MCM 4- Construction Site Runoff Control**

### **IDDE for Construction Sites**

*.5 PDH - This course teaches the learner how to identify an illicit discharge, report an illicit discharge, and how to receive a call of an illicit discharge specific to construction sites. The student will also learn key terms, historical context of the Clean Water Act, and what constitutes a potential pollutant. A score of 70% or higher is required to pass the course. Upon completion, learners will receive a completion certificate.*

### **Construction Stormwater Training**

2.0 PDH - This 5 module course is intended to educate all learners, public and private, on the purpose and requirements of erosion/sediment control and stormwater programs in relation to construction projects throughout their life-cycles.

## **Construction Site Runoff Control For Permittees**

### **Why Train Subs**

1.0 PDH - In this webinar, we discuss the reasons why construction contractors should train their subcontractors on stormwater pollution prevention and the methods they can use to accomplish this task, usually at no cost to themselves.

### **Stormwater Training for Excavation Subcontractors**

0.5 PDH - This training is for subcontractors working on construction projects. It is specifically directed to those that perform excavation, earthwork, or utilities.

### **Stormwater Training for Concrete Subcontractors**

0.5 PDH - This course is designed for subcontractors that perform concrete, asphalt, stucco, and brick laying work.

### **Stormwater Training for Vertical Construction**

0.5 PDH - This training module is designed to teach the principals of stormwater pollution prevention in regards specifically to vertical construction subcontractors.

### **Stormwater Training for Landscaping Subcontractors**

0.5 PDH - This training is designed to educate individuals in stormwater regulations as they apply to landscaping efforts.

### **Construction Stormwater Inspector Training**

2.0 PDH - This 5 module course is intended to educate learners on the purpose and requirements of stormwater programs in relation to construction projects throughout its life-cycle.

## **MCM 5- Post Construction Runoff Control**

### **Long-Term Private Sector Stormwater Training**

0.5 PDH - A training course for MS4s to provide to their own employees and to the private sector on long-term stormwater management which educates everyone on stormwater considerations for facilities and properties.

## **MCM 6- Pollution Prevention/Good Housekeeping**

### **SPCC - Spill Prevention Control and Countermeasures**

0.5 PDH - Stormwater training on controls and countermeasures for spills. For learners that inspect or regulate sites with fuels and other hazardous liquids.

### **Landscape for Municipal Employees**

0.5 PDH - Stormwater training for municipal employees with performing or overseeing landscaping responsibilities. It covers the considerations of preparing for, doing, and cleaning up after landscaping. *A score of 70% or higher is required to pass the course. Upon completion, learners will receive a completion certificate.*

### **Street Sweeping**

*0.5 PDH - This course is intended for employees who perform street sweeping duties. This course teaches learners how to perform street sweeping tasks efficiently, minimize pollutant discharge while sweeping, and control the wastes produced by street sweeping. A score of 70% or higher is required to pass the course. Upon completion, learners will receive a completion certificate.*

### **Fueling and Maintenance**

*0.5 PDH - This course is intended for employees who perform fueling and maintenance on vehicles. This course teaches learners how to reduce pollution from fueling and maintenance activities, reduce and contain spills, and dispose of waste materials and equipment associated with these activities. A score of 70% or higher is required to pass the course. Upon completion, learners will receive a completion certificate.*

### **Rights of Way**

*1.0 PDH - This course is intended for employees who maintain infrastructure, and gives them strategies for minimizing pollutant discharges during their work. This course teaches learners to manage the materials in right of way work, control pollutants during these activities, and properly dispose of wastes generated by those activities. A score of 70% or higher is required to pass the course. Upon completion, learners will receive a completion certificate.*

## **MCM 7- Industrial Stormwater Sources**

### **IDDE for Industrial Facilities**

*.5 PDH - This course teaches the learner how to identify an illicit discharge, report an illicit discharge, and how to receive a call of an illicit discharge specific to industrial facilities. The student will also learn key terms, historical context of the Clean Water Act, and what constitutes a potential pollutant. A score of 70% or higher is required to pass the course. Upon completion, learners will receive a completion certificate.*
